STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN ACTIVITIES and SOURCES OF FINANCING *

North Clackamas County Water Commission's primary source of revenue is wholesale service charges from member agencies. The Commission is proposing a 4.2% increase in its wholesale service charge rates to ensure gross revenues are exceeding its ongoing operating requirements. Personnel services is increasing 1.2% as a result of labor rate increases. Materials and services increases 8.6% due to inflationary cost increases on electricty and wholesale water purchases. Capital outlay is projected to be lower than the previous year due to completion of high cost planned asset renewal and replacements. To reduce future retirement cost, the Commission will combine fiscal year 2024 initial PERS Side-Account funding with this fiscal year's funding to offset fiscal year 2025 and future retirement rate increases. The Commission is confident it can anticipate favorable financial results and a resulting financial position in fiscal year
