2024: STATE AND FEDERAL AGENDA

➤ Federal Funding

- FY25 Congressionally Directed Funding – EPA/STAG Appropriations Request for Tertiary Treatment
- Finance Mechanisms - OLWS determined financing through federally-funded State Revolving Loan Fund was more advantageous than through Federal WIFIA Funds
- Authorization in the House & Senate Water Resources Development Acts (WRDA)

➤ State Funding

- Legislatively Directed Funding – \$3 million in State Funding for Tertiary Treatment



2024: RESULTS

Federal

- Oak Lodge's Authorization included in the Senate and House versions of WRDA
- Oak Lodge's Appropriations Request was not included in either version of the EPA's Appropriation Bill, despite being requested by the Oregon Senators.

State

- \$3 million included for Oak Lodge's Tertiary Treatment Plant in Senate Bill SB 1530

2025: STATE AND FEDERAL OPPORTUNITIES

- State: 2025 Legislatively Directed Funding
 - Funding for Infiltration and Inflow Projects - \$3-5 million

- Federal: FY 26 Congressionally Directed Spending Requests
 - \$1-2 million from EPA's State and Tribal Assistance Grant Program
 - \$1-2 million from the Corps of Engineers for Infiltration and Inflow Projects
