OLWS Governance

OLWS is governed by a Board of Directors comprised of five community members elected to four-year terms by voters. The Board holds regular public meetings on the second Tuesday of each month beginning at 4:00 p.m. visit our website at OakLodgeWaterServices.org or call (503) 654-4227 for more details.

Drinking Water Services

OLWS provides safe, reliable drinking water from the Clackamas River. Customer rates fund essential services, including purchasing clean water and maintaining daily operations, and investments in infrastructure.



Wastewater Services

OLWS collects wastewater from homes and businesses so the water can be cleaned and safely returned to the Willamette River. Customer rates fund essential services, including wastewater treatment, maintaining daily operations, and investments in the treatment plant as well infrastructure. Approximately 1.5 billion gallons of wastewater is cleaned and returned to the Willamette River each year.



Watershed Protection

OLWS helps protect the environment by monitoring water quality in local waterways and helping to keep the Clackamas County-owned stormwater system clean. Customer rates fund watershed protection activities necessary to comply with state and federal water quality permit requirements.



Billing Structure

Customers are billed monthly based on actual usage. Bills are calculated individually based on fixed rates, average winter water use, and water meter reads for the service period.

The drinking water bill portion includes a service charge and a consumption charge. The consumption charge varies for each bill and is determined by reading the water meter. The wastewater rates are fixed once per year and include a fixed rate service charge, a watershed protection fee, and a rate that varies dependent on winter average water use.

Bills will fluctuate depending on water consumption and will increase in summer months dependent on outdoor water use. Visit our website to see current rates and fees.
