I attended as an alternate as Paul Gornick was out of town. Most of the agenda was devoted to discussion of who should represent Clackamas County cities on the Regional Toll Advisory Committee. The discussion was centered on whether it should be someone from a city having substantial impact like West Linn or Oregon City or representing Clackamas County more broadly, or supportive of tolling or not. After a couple of slates were tested, the approved representation is Kathy Hyzy from Milwaukie and Brian Hodson from Canby as an alternate. There was substantial discussion about who should be appointed to the Tolling Diversion subcommittee and concern about having someone from C-4 be the representative. However, on a 5-4 vote, the president of the West Linn City Council, Rory Bialostosky, who is not on C-4, will be the representative. Paul Savas is the County representative on the Regional Toll Advisory Committee.

There was also discussion on the Oregon Highway Plan Policy Amendment concerning congestion pricing. It was felt that there should be a sunset clause and that the discussions on this policy need to be taken to the specific communities impacted by it.
